Adult Exploitation

Exploitation is when a person is groomed, forced or coerced into doing something they do not want to do for another person's gain. At times, an activity may appear consensual. A person's age, capacity and vulnerability may impact on their freedom to choose and make their own decisions. We consider these people to be victims. Victims are often trapped or feel trapped and unable to tell others what is happening. Here in St. Theresa's, we will always offer support.
