We are also having a Parish Liturgy Committee, Parish Hall Committee, Parish Social Committee and the Parish Pastoral Council. I am immensely touched by your generous volunteering spirit in this parish. A big thank-you to all who are willing/able to volunteer to serve in these committees. Your help is very much appreciated. On behalf of the Parish, our special and prayerful thanks go to all current Finance Committee members who were appointed by my predecessors and who have served so well for those years. In the end, it is the Faith in Christ and Love of God that motivates all of us to volunteer and serve the Church.

Our Parish gifted with a Lectionary : 1 am very pleased to report that two parishioners have offered to buy for the parish **one of the three required volumes** of the Lectionary. **Volume I** is for Sunday Mass, **Volume II** for Weekday Mass, and **Volume III** is for Ritual Celebrations (Readings for Funerals, Weddings etc). Current Lectionaries and Mass Books will become redundant as from the first Sunday of Advent 2024 and give way to new ones for greater fidelity to the Original texts. Mass books are retailing at £5.95 each or at £4.95 each on orders of over 100 Mass Books. The Lectionary is retailing about £550 per Volume (we need three Volumes).
